Puzzling Puzzles 拼图片片,想象无限

Have you ever done a <u>wasgij</u> or a <u>photomosaic</u>? Or are you feeling puzzled? Well, maybe you haven't **puzzled over** a wasgij, but chances are you've pieced together a jigsaw puzzle.

你做过 wasgij 或相片马赛克吗?还是你正觉得困惑不已?也许你还没有为了玩 wasgij 绞尽脑汁过,但是你应该曾经拼过拼图。

The jigsaw dates back to the 1760s, when London- based mapmaker <u>John Spilsbury</u> stuck one of his maps to a sheet of wood. He cut around the **borders** of the countries, creating an educational game that would help schoolchildren learn geography. Later, manufacturers would use different materials, like **plywood** and **cardboard**, and experiment with **diverse** designs. Soon, jigsaws were more than a learning tool; they became a popular pastime.

拼图的历史最早可追溯到 1760 年代,伦敦地图制作家约翰. 史毕尔斯伯里把他的其中一张地图贴到一片木板上。他沿着国家边界切割,创造出一种寓教于乐的游戏用以帮助学童学习地理。后来,制造商会用胶合板或是硬纸板之类不同材质制作拼图,并且实验各种不同的设计。不久,拼图不只是一个学习的工具;它们变成一种受欢迎的休闲嗜好。

Over the years, jigsaws grew more **complicated**, with more pieces. **So-called** impossipuzzles have repetitive designs, like <u>Smarties</u> or baked beans, and are extremely difficult to solve. There's even a picture-less jigsaw, as well as <u>3D</u> puzzles of globes, cities, and **skyscrapers**.

这些年来,拼图的发展由于片数增加而变得更加复杂困难。所谓的「不可能的拼图」有着重复性的图案设计,例如雀巢聪明豆或是烤豆子,因此相当难解。甚至还有没有图案的拼图,以及球体、城市和摩天大楼等的 3D 立体拼图。

Are you still confused about the wasgij? Well, it's a "cult jigsaw." The picture on the box shows a different perspective than the puzzle inside. In case you hadn't noticed, wasgij is jigsaw spelled backwards! The photomosaic might also have you scratching your head. Close up, many varied little images are visible, but from a distance, the eye sees one single complete picture.

你还在苦思 wasgij 是什么吗?它是一种深受某些狂热份子所喜爱的拼图。拼图外盒上的图案所呈现的是完成图的另一个面向。万一你还没注意到,wasgij 其实就是 jigsaw 这个字的颠倒拼法。相片马赛克可能也让你想破头了。当近看时相片马赛克能看到一幅幅不同的小张图画,但是远看就会看到一张完整的图画。

Alternatively, you could try the world's largest jigsaw, with 24,000 pieces! For those without the space for a puzzle of these **dimensions**, try an online jigsaw instead. There are numerous options for jigsaw fun. So don't **fall to pieces** – take a deep breath and start solving the puzzle piece by piece!
